

Grand Ledge Swim Club Code of Conduct

Each swimmer on the Grand Ledge Swim Club is a representative of the club at all times. As such, we expect each and every swimmer to set a good example for other team members, swimmers from other clubs, and the general public. The coaches will advise you of expectations at practice or at meets, and you should feel free to ask coaches any questions you may have about these expectations, and discuss them with your family.

The Grand Ledge Swim Club is lucky enough to have use of the Grand Ledge High School pool. Accordingly, when you swim, you are expected to comply with the Grand Ledge Swim Club Handbook and also with the Grand Ledge Public Schools Elementary Student or Middle School Student Handbook (as applicable). The GLSC handbook is posted on the GLSC website and the GLPS handbooks are posted on the GLPS website.

If a swimmer becomes a problem to coaches or other swimmers at a particular practice or meet, he or she will be asked to sit out. If unacceptable behavior continues, a coach may ask a swimmer to leave practice. In addition to any disciplinary action that may be imposed by the Grand Ledge Public Schools, violation of the GLSC or GLPS Codes of Conduct may also result, at the discretion of the head coach, in suspension from the club for an indefinite period of time and/or permanent expulsion from the club, without refund of any registration fee.

You are capable of great things both in and out of the pool. Please remember to act in a safe, responsible and respectful manner at all times and be proud of yourself, your club and your sport!
