

JACKET AND STATE INFORMATION

At the end of the USS Short-Course season (usually March) the GRAND LEDGE SWIM CLUB holds an annual Awards Banquet.

Swimmers are entitled to receive a swim club jacket after fulfilling certain requirements with the club. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT TO FILL OUT THE PAPERWORK AND ORDER THE JACKET THROUGH THE AWARDS CHAIRPERSON.**

JACKET INFORMATION

The requirements that must be fulfilled in order for your child to receive a club jacket are as follows:

1. The swimmer must be a current member of United States Swimming and GLSC in good standing.
2. The swimmer must not be a member of another swim club.
3. The swimmer must have participated in at least 10 meets: **4 - USS meets and 6 - other meets.**
4. The swimmer must have completed at least five terms with GLSC (these can be non-consecutive and middle school swimming counts as ONE term).
5. The swimmer must be actively swimming in the term we hold the banquet.
6. The jacket order form must be completed and turned in by the designated due date. Completed sheets may be turned in to the coaching staff or volunteer awards chairperson.
7. If the jacket order form is not completed and handed in on time, your child will not receive a jacket. *There is only one jacket order per year and if the deadline is missed, the swimmer will have to submit the jacket request the following year.*
8. If your child needs to swim in a meet during the winter term, note this on the jacket order form and the awards chairperson will confirm that the swimmer swam in the meets.

STATE/ZONE (Q1) QUALIFIERS

The requirements that must be fulfilled in order for your child to be recognized for achieving a short/long course state time or relay time are as follows:

1. The awards form must be completed and returned by the first Monday of March. If your swimmer qualifies for the state meet after this time you may contact the awards chairperson.
2. If your child is close to qualifying and has to swim a meet during the winter term to qualify for states or zones, please notify the awards chairperson of the situation.
3. It is the responsibility of the parent to notify the awards chairperson if the state or zone time is made and at which meet.
